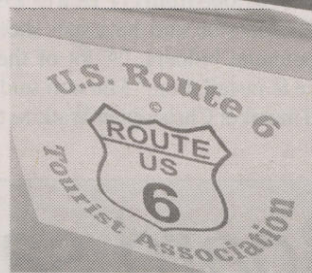


CRUISING INTO WILTON!
