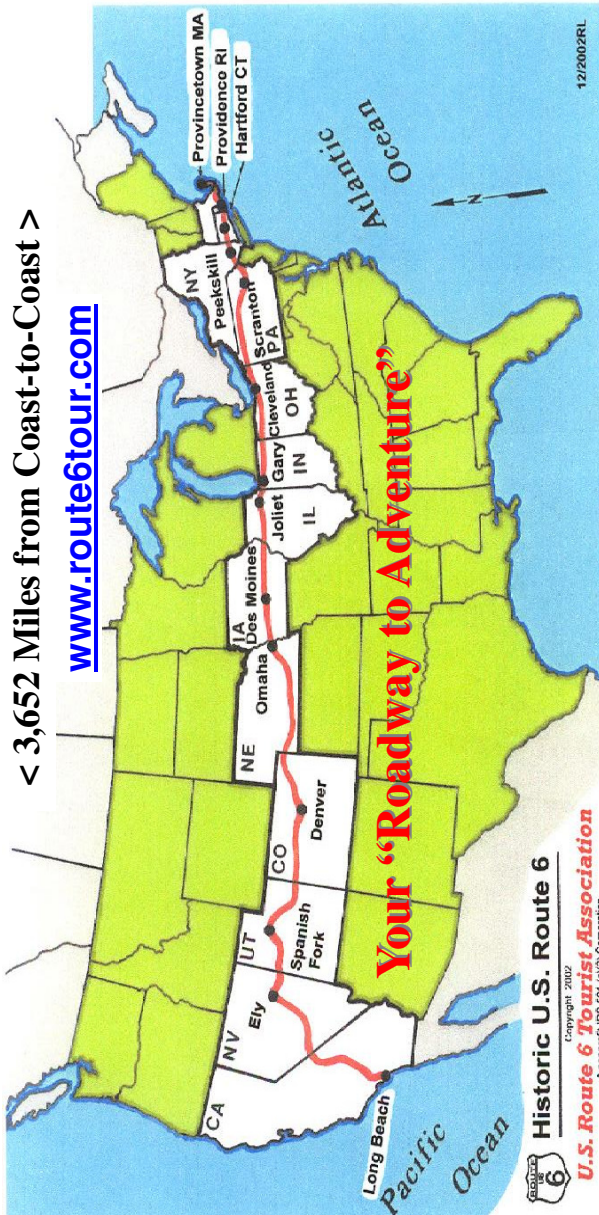

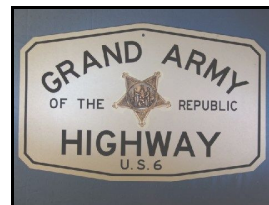


Rachel V. Carey
